Dear Parent,

Please find below details of work that your child needs to work on during the course of the closure.

1. Encourage your child to complete independent **research project** on our World Around Us topic "**Bean to Bar**." The children have the guidelines for this project in their homework books and it should be used to ensure they have included the relevant information.
2. **Learning books** have been sent home which contain all spelling lists, spelling rules and mental maths topics covered to date. Revising these will benefit your child.
3. **Reading group novels** have been sent home, therefore children should continue to read a chapter each night.
4. Encourage your child to carry out **daily reading activities**. Child can read their library books or read from magazines, newspapers, comic books, fact-files, bible stories etc... Shared reading and discussions alongside your child's reading helps develop their interpretations of the text read.
5. Log on to **Mathletics** and carry out daily challenges and work set by Mrs Meenan. Mathletics complements the **numeracy** curriculum topics and reinforces topics, strategies and concepts covered during classroom learning.
6. New **Spelling Lists** will be uploaded to the Primary 7 Digital Learning area of the school website. Please encourage children to carry out spelling activities linked to each day.
7. Use **Topmarks** interactive website ([www.topmarks.co.uk](http://www.topmarks.co.uk)) as a revision tool with your child. This website is an interactive learning zone which covers a range of **Numeracy**, **Literacy** and other curriculum topics in a fun and engaging way.
8. Use internet websites such as BBC bitesize, Twinkl and Maths-drills to carry out **revision** of all topics covered to date .Topics covered this year to date include:

9. **Learning resource packs** have been provided and should be worked through. Including in the packs are Mental Arithmetic, grammar and comprehension activities. Text books have also been provided which I will provide guidance to on the class page of the school website.
