- Some might have had a dragon heads or circular object coming out of the bow.
- 7. Viking ships were used for long -distance trade, exploration and colonisation.
- 8. They are usually in 2 categories, either merchant ships or warships.
- Most Viking ships were built for sailing rivers
  and coastal waters while some could travel on
  the open sea, even the Ocean.
- 10. The Viking warrior symbol 'Hraethigaldur' means "Put fear in the enemy." I have drawn this this Viking symbol on my boat.
