



## **Important Information for Parents/Carers of Children Starting Rosemount Nursery September 2020.**

### **Guidelines for parents.**

- Only **one** parent/carer must accompany a child into nursery for drop off and collection.
- Anyone with other children will have to wait outside until a member of staff is available to bring your child out. This will be after all children have been dismissed.
- Adults must sanitise before entering the nursery.
- Parents/carers are only allowed into the nursery setting briefly at drop off and pick up times.
- All parents/carers must wear a face mask whilst in the nursery building.
- Parents/carers must not stand about and all parents are responsible for social distancing.
- If you wish to speak to the class teacher you can talk over the phone, arrange an appointment or wait until all the other children have been handed over to their parents/carers. In this instance please collect your child and wait outside until the teacher is free.
- Please refrain from touching anything within the nursery to lessen the chance of the spread of covid 19.

**These procedures will be continually monitored and may be subject to change.**

### **Drop off and collection procedure**

To allow parents/carers access into the nursery at drop off time and collecting time we have decided to operate a one-way system. Parents/carers will enter the nursery through the front door. Children will go straight to quiet room and staff will instruct them to hang up coats once all adults have left the nursery. Parents/carers must then exit through the back door and leave through the

nursery playground. At collection time parents/carers will enter through the front door again, children will be released to parents/carers from the quiet room and then you leave with your child through the back door. Parents must adhere to social distancing at all times between other adults and children. Please be patient.
